Summary of Programme

About 25% of the course will be devoted to theoretical aspects of FB in children

- Equipment needed to set up a bronchoscopy in children
- Indications, contraindications
- Anaesthesia, sedation, tolerance, side effects
- Anatomical findings : upper and lower airways (normal/abnormal)
- Bronchoalveolar lavage (techniques, indications, results)
- Bronchial brushing, biopsy, transbronchial biopsy
- FB in NICU

About 25 % will be devoted to discussions of cases during video sessions

50 % of the course will be devoted to hands on sessions. Participants will work on sleepy piglets in operating room under supervision of international recognized tutors. Six sessions lasting 90 minutes will focus on

- Practical handling
- Bronchoalveolar lavage
- Bronchial biopsy
- Transbronchial biopsy
- Intubation with flexible bronchoscope

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
